BUCKS RURAL BUSINESS GRANT

Small rural businesses in Buckingham and the villages are eligible to apply for the Bucks Rural Business Grant valued from £2.5k up to £300k, to help with building and equipment costs, and creating opportunities for businesses to start, grow or increase employment opportunities.

The grant focuses on supporting rural business investment priorities such as funding for small scale investment in micro and small enterprises in rural areas, including capital funding for net-zero infrastructure for rural businesses; and diversification of farm business outside of agriculture to startup, expand or scale up of businesses, where this involves converting farm buildings into other commercial or business uses.

There is currently £1.7million grant funding remaining for a wide range of projects, including farm diversification, tourism initiatives, community projects, and forestry activities, which must be completed, and funding claimed by 31 March 2025.
